



Federation Executive Board Chooses e-Division Rather than eNARFE Chapter

The NC Federation Executive Board has voted to cease its efforts to establish an eNARFE North Carolina Chapter and to work with NARFE Headquarters to establish a North Carolina e-Division instead. This decision is a result of the new national eNARFE policies that came out of the moratorium on new eNARFE chapters established by the NARFE National Executive Board in October. The NC Federation Executive Board now encourages any current or future members of NARFE interested in eNARFE membership to join the national eNARFE Chapter 2363. Members of Chapter 2363 who reside in North Carolina will become "virtual" members of the North Carolina e-Division.
