For you, Dues Withholding is the painless way to pay your NARFE National and Chapter Dues. It takes less than five minutes to fill out the form and one stamp to mail it to NARFE headquarters. You will never have to write another check, fill out another form or use another stamp and you save \$4.44 per year.

For NARFE, dues withholding saves the cost of processing, printing and mailing renewal notices. It costs NARFE 61 cents to print and mail each renewal notice. A Dues Withholding Application is available on page 41 of your March 2008 NARFE magazine. Mail it today and you will receive a postcard from Richard Ostergren, our National Treasurer, informing you when the dues withholding will become effective (on the expiration date of your current membership). SENIOR TAR HEEL LEGISLATURE SPEAKER TO MAKE TWO PRESENTATIONS TO THE NC STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING

Our own Charles Dickens has been invited by the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging to present the Senior Tar Heel Legislature's legislative priorities for 2008 at a public session on February 28. The Commission was created by the General Assembly to study and evaluate the existing delivery system of State services to older adults and to recommend an improved system of delivery to meet the present and future needs of older adults. Also at that meeting, the Commission has arranged for a separate presentation on Project C.A.R.E. (Caregiver Alternatives to Running on Empty), one of the five STHL legislative priorities. In this presentation, Speaker Dickens will be joined by Lisa Gwyther of the Duke Aging Center Family Support Program. She is a nationally known expert on dementia and caregiving. The meeting date is February 28 at 1:00 p.m. in Room 544 of the Legislative Office Building.

NARFE: SEEKING CERTAIN RETIREES

As featured in the article on page 18 of the January 2008 NARFE magazine, a class-action lawsuit is pending against smaller Federal agencies that did not fully pay retirees for their unused annual leave. The case stems from the similar Archuleta suit. We are looking for members or any former federal workers who retired or separated in the last two months (November and December) of the years 1993 to 1999 from any of the federal agencies listed below. Please spread the word to your chapter and federation members and urge those affected, or who think they may be affected to immediately contact the plaintiffs' attorney, Ira Lechner, who needs to hear from affected individuals as soon as possible. The Justice Department is arguing that unless Mr. Lechner presents at least a few retirees from each agency listed, all former

employees of that agency will be excluded from any possible settlement, including back pay and interest. If elected the Region X Vice President, I will work as a team player in striving to achieve the goals of organizational growth and commitment to safeguarding the critical mission of NARFE.

FEBRUARY MEETING NOTES

Beth Burdick of Ashford Mortgage Advisors discussed some misconceptions of reverse mortgages and, in response to a question, described three different types. Kate Beatty of Kim & Company Real Estate emphasized the need to pick the right agent if buying or selling real estate. She emphasized that procedures for condos are quite different than for family homes, such as restrictions on "what you can do on the property."

Elaine Hughes installed Sabine Dieringer as the new First VP, in charge of membership issues. Treasurer Bruce Habermann gave his report, noting that two large payments for NC Federation dues, and our Alzheimer's contribution, were made this month. He said the 990-N, now required by the IRS, had been sent electronically. Bety Downey, Benevolence Chair, reported two new members and three deaths on the latest report. Frank reported for that most of us would be eligible for the \$600/person rebate. Elaine announced that she would be a delegate at the National Convention. Frank strongly urged dues withholding, pointing out it saves money for both the member and the National Office. He noted the Chapter dues' withholding rate is 22. % which beats the National average of 16%. He also asked if any member wishing to be a delegate to the State Convention – April 29 – May 1, 2008 – to let him know. Charles Dickens thanked Elaine for the opportunity to write an article for the Federation newsletter on "Project Care", which is about Alzheimer caregivers. Theron Rumsey, as Membership Chair for the NC Federation, said he wants to keep the "Every Member Bring a Member" theme alive. He reported that recent NC membership figures have trended up, crediting vigorous follow-up of lapsing members.

In 1996, Secretary of State Elaine F. Marshall became the first woman ever elected to a statewide, executive branch office in North Carolina.

Secretary Marshall was a member of the NC State Senate before rising to statewide office. She holds a B.S. in Home Economics from the University of Maryland and a law degree from Campbell University. She has received Honorary Doctorate Degrees from Lees McRae College and Meredith College.

Her work experiences include teaching Home Economics in the public school and community college systems, co-ownership of a book and gift store, establishing an interior decorating business and the private practice of law.

Secretary Marshall has been very active in many civic groups in the areas of child welfare, women's issues, and agriculture and small town economic development.

Since becoming Secretary of State, she has received numerous state and national awards for leadership in technology, government innovation, and women's leadership. These awards include:

- The North Carolina 4-H Lifetime Achievement Award;
- The Distinguished Attorney Award from the North Carolina Association of Women Attorneys -- a group that has only awarded this honor twice in its entire history;
- Induction into the Honor Society of Agriculture of N.C. State University;
- The Common Cause North Carolina Leadership in Government Award;
- The North Carolina Association of Educators' Women's Equality Award;
- The Delta Kappa Gamma Society's Eta State Founders Award;
- The Lifetime Achievement Award for Women in Business by the Triangle Business Journal;
- The National Notary Association's 2006 Achievement Award and being named to its list of "The 50 Most Influential People in Notarization in the Last 50 Years";
- Serving as President in 2007 of the National Electronic Commerce Coordinating Council, an organization dedicated to bringing best technology practices into all levels of government across this country;
- Recognized as the leader in state Trademark protection by the US Chamber of Commerce, the International Anti-Counterfeiting Coalition, and Underwriters Laboratories;
- And Secretary Marshall has even received an official "Gold Record" from the Recording Industry Association of America for her law enforcement work to protect Trademarked goods and patent holders.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

On Tuesday, March 11, a group of Chapter 214 members attended the NARFE Area I Workshop in Clyde, NC. I attended with Frank and Pat Coperich along with our newest Chapter member, Jay Farris, the one day Workshop that covered Legislative Affairs, Leadership and Membership issues. In the Legislative group, I presented my review of the Generic Case Study of the typical North Carolina federal annuitant. I learned that this analysis was passed on to National and that it was suggested that all state NARFE organizations prepare a similar analysis for their

Congressional delegations and State Legislatures so that they could more effectively argue their cases for support. The Leadership and Membership groups presented ways to best improve our development of future Chapter leaders and how to gain and retain members. Stress was placed on the need for two year term limits in each chapter in order to rotate new ideas and people into positions of responsibility.

The Membership report discussed the pending “Baby Boom” generation retirement and how they are more and more dependent on a “computer savvy” communication network. NARFE is considering shifting more emphasis to “virtual” web sites for information exchange. However, I pointed out the importance of other mediums, such as this Newsletter, that are often the only means of contacting many NARFE members who don't have, or don't wish to have, access to computers. Within our Chapter,

roughly 50 members acknowledge the use of computers for NARFE communication, while nearly 130 do not have access, or chose not to use computers. The Area I representatives at the meeting acknowledged the Chapter 214 Newsletter, as well as that of the Asheville chapter, as outstanding mediums for NARFE information. Our complements to our Newsletter Editor, Marlene Jimenez, for an outstanding job. Unfortunately, many Chapters within Area I find it difficult to support or maintain Newsletters.

Our Picnic Committee has begun the process of preparing to host this year's Annual Picnic. Again, this will be an Area I wide event. As soon as details of the planned August 15th event are finalized, we will keep you informed. (Cont'd Page 2)

Because of the extended voting period for the elections in Henderson County, the Flat Rock Village Hall will be used for voting during our next scheduled meeting in April and again in October. Therefore, we will be temporarily meeting in locations other than the Flat Rock Village Hall on those dates. In these trying economic times there is good news on the horizon. Congress has started the budgeting process for 2009 and thus far no reductions of funding for retired federal employees are being considered. This is an election year.

IT'S HAPPENING ON CAPITAL HILL

The good news is the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program Authorizing Law protects its enrollees from having their health benefits reduced when they turn 65 and become Medicare eligible. For others, the Equal Employment Opportunities Commission will now allow employers to reduce health benefits to retirees based on age.

Legislation (H.R. 4777) has been reintroduced by Rep. Nydia M. Velazquez (D-NY), which would prevent the erosion of deferred federal annuitant retirement benefits and eliminate a disparity in spousal protection for deferred annuitants. If you are a deferred annuitant, you can join a grass-roots effort to support this bill by contacting Jim Cowie of Chapter 0581 in Gaithersburg, MD (301-515-3005, jamescowie@worldnet.net).

March is NARFE-PAC month. If you haven't done so, you are urged to support NARFE-PAC by sending in a contribution that will assist NARFE with access and clout on Capital Hill. See your March issue of the NARFE magazine, page 19, for information about NARFE-PAC and a contribution form.

Two bill introductions are of interest to NARFE members. Rep. Jim Moran, D-VA, introduced H.R. 5573, legislation to provide Federal Employees Retirement System accumulated sick leave to be partially "cashed out" at retirement. Rep. Danny Davis, D-IL, introduced H.R. 5550, legislation to increase the maximum age to qualify for coverage as a "child" under the health benefits program for Federal employees. Introduced at this point in the second year of a two-year Congress, neither bill is likely to win enactment. Both bills could be reintroduced in the next Congress.

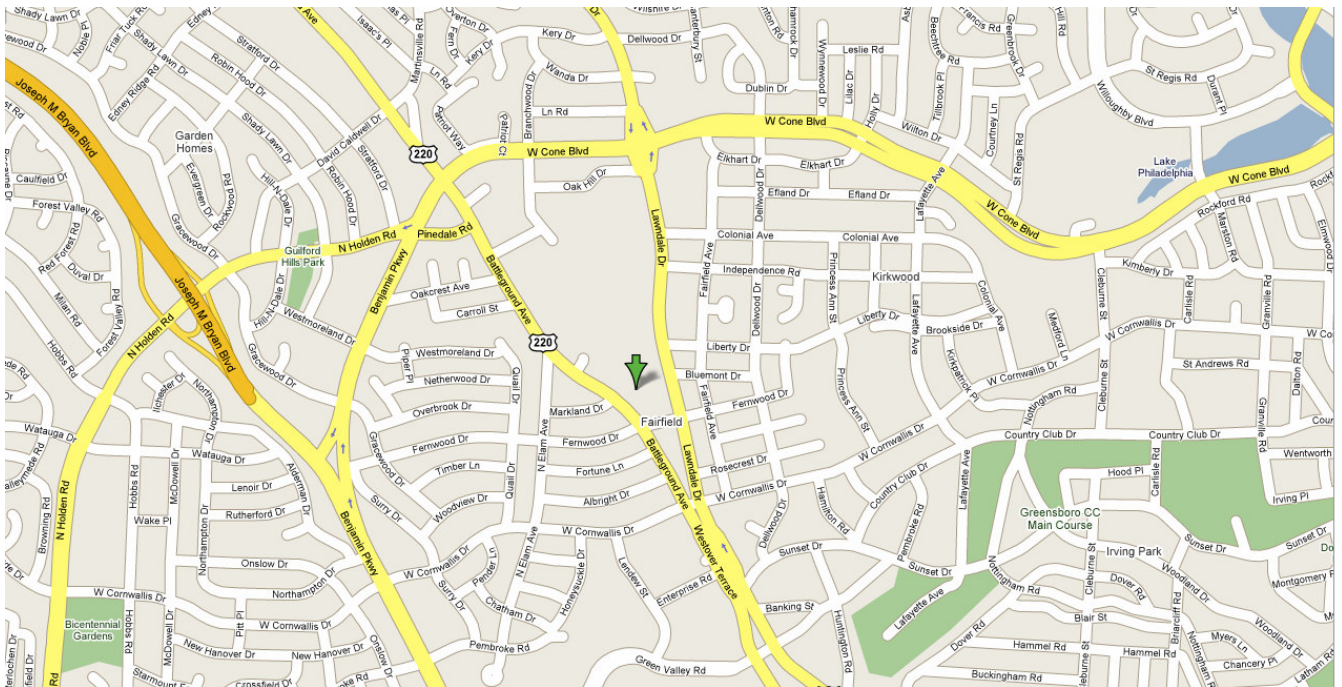

President's Message

Give it a chance!

I want to thank the many members who turned out for the decision-making about our future meeting place. The discussion was candid yet civil and a clear majority was in favor of moving the meeting place.

I had no strong feelings either way on this move and actually stood there for a moment staring at my ballot. I ended up voting in favor of the move because I have attended other meetings at Golden Corral and the meeting spaces have been far superior to what we have at the Chinese buffet.

Many of our members want a lunch with the meeting and that rules out most free places to meet. While I do not partake of a Chinese buffet, I have found that a Golden Corral lunch is an excellent value. I pay about the same amount for a grilled chicken salad at my weekly Kiwanis meeting (Captain Bill's) that a buffet costs at Golden Corral. My challenge will be to limit myself to one plate.

If you opposed the move, I fully understand. I ask, however, that you give the new place a try. We may all be pleasantly surprised. If you have come to a meeting at the Chinese buffet and been turned off by the location then it's time to attend another meeting.

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Legislative Issues

On March 14, the Labor Department's Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, the CPI-W, for February 2008 is **207.254**, up **0.2 percent** from the January index of 206.7. The CPI-W for February is **1.8 percent higher** than the 2007 third quarter average base index of 203.6. For purposes of calculating the next COLA (cost-of-living adjustment) the index has risen **1.8 percent**. March consumer price news will be released Wednesday, April 16.

Former federal employees now receiving monthly benefits under provisions of the Federal Employees Compensation Act (FECA) receive a COLA based on the change in the CPI-W during each calendar year. The February 2007 index of 207.254, is **0.8 percent** higher than the December 2007 index of 205.7. The CPI-W increase during calendar year 2007 was 4.3 percent, meaning that FECA beneficiaries will

see a **4.3 percent** COLA in their April benefit payments.

The House and Senate passage of their respective budget resolutions (H. Con. Res. 312 and S. Con. Res. 70), allows staff to start the process for a House-Senate conference committee. Neither the House nor Senate budget resolution proposes reductions in federal retirement or health benefits. The Congressional budget resolution does not require a presidential signature nor does it carry the force of law. However, Congress uses it as a blueprint to direct its decisions about spending and taxation.

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NARFE Concerned by OPM Proposal for Separate FEHBP Retiree Coverage and Expansion of HSAs

National Active and Retired Federal Employees Association (NARFE) President Margaret L. Baptiste expressed NARFE's concerns about new OPM proposals which would create separate

health plans for Medicare-eligible federal annuitants and expand controversial Health Savings Accounts (HSAs). However, Baptiste applauded OPM's decision to encourage FEHBP carriers to offer enhanced hearing benefits for adults, including professional services and hearing aids.

"While OPM says that enrollees in the Medicare pilot "sub-option" would pay the same premiums set for their counterpart FEHBP plans, we are troubled that a plan specifically created for Medicare-eligible federal annuitants could open the door for separately rated retiree plans in the future with substantially higher premiums than other FEHBP plans," the NARFE President said. "In the 48 year history of the program, there has never been a separate FEHBP plan based on retirement status or age."

Baptiste also said that NARFE is concerned that the cost of the Medicare pilot sub-option's "pass-through accounts" could result in benefit cuts or higher deductibles, copayments and coinsurance for federal retirees and survivors.

In addition, the Association is disturbed that payments from the pass-through accounts would be used to encourage federal annuitants to join private Medicare options, like "Medicare Advantage" and the Medicare "Part D" prescription drug program.

According to Baptiste, the President's fiscal year (FY) 2009 budget would weaken traditional Medicare by reducing payments to doctors and hospitals and, as a result, make private Medicare Advantage (MA) plans more attractive to beneficiaries. Most federal annuitants enroll in traditional Medicare because the program's coverage coordinates better with FEHBP benefits than Medicare Advantage. Recent studies have shown that Medicare Advantage plans are paid more than the average traditional-fee-for-service Medicare plan in their area. NARFE, and its 53 member Leadership Council of Aging Organizations (LCAO) sister organizations, have urged lawmakers to cut overpayments to Medicare Advantage plans ensuring equitable funding and treatment of all beneficiaries by the Medicare program.

The Medicare Part D program was created to offer a prescription drug benefit for the 16 million older Americans who had no such coverage. Federal annuitants do not need to pay the Part D premium because they currently receive drug coverage through their FEHBP plan. NARFE has long been concerned that Medicare Part D would encourage employers, including the federal government, to reduce or eliminate prescription drug coverage to Medicare-eligible retirees under FEHBP. Part D drug coverage is substantially inferior to what FEHBP now provides.

To add insult to injury, OPM persistently has refused to apply for a payment -- available to other public and private employers who provide drug coverage as generous as Medicare Part D -- which could be used to lower FEHBP premiums.

OPM continues to encourage FEHBP insurance carriers to expand the availability of High Deductible Health Plan/Health Savings Accounts (HDHP/HSA) despite the fact that the controversial option has only attracted a minute fraction of federal workers and retirees. Indeed, a report released March 18 by the nonpartisan Employee Benefit Research Institute (EBRI) and the Commonwealth Fund found "little evidence that the tax benefits of such plans [HDHS/HSAs] have the potential to help change the trajectory of health care cost growth, are leading health plans or providers to provide more information about the quality and price of services to patients..."

NARFE opposes HSAs because they could increase premiums for comprehensive plans since relatively healthy enrollees with higher incomes could be siphoned off into HSAs. Such concerns were confirmed by a January 2006 report of the nonpartisan Government Accountability Office (GAO), which found that HSAs tended to attract younger and wealthier FEHBP enrollees.

NARFE opposes OPM's decision in their 2008 call letter to solicit proposals for insurance carriers to offer the long dormant "Indemnity Benefit Plan" as a backdoor attempt to jump start anemic participation in HDHP/HSAs. The President's FY 2009 budget said that the "Indemnity Benefit Plan" should provide HSAs as a system-wide option. Despite being named in the law which authorizes FEHBP, the Indemnity plan has not been available since the Aetna insurance company stopped offering the coverage in 1990. The entry of a large insurance carrier with an HDHP/HSA option available to most enrollees also could boost participation in HSAs.

DID YOU KNOW??

Many current NARFE members have retired under the CSRS (Civil Service Retirement System) but an increasing number of retirees (those who converted to the Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS) during their working years) as well as current federal employees, are covered under the FERS. We will cover the FERS in this newsletter and continue in the next newsletter to discuss the survivor benefits under FERS.

FERS is designed to coordinate with Society Security. FERS is a three part coordinated plan. It is based on Social Security (a social insurance system, which provides benefits, once the requirements have been met). Then a defined benefit annuity is added -- the FERS basic annuity to reward long term employment. Finally, the Thrift Savings Plan encourages federal employees to save for their retirement and extend financial protection from disability or death. Each of the three parts of FERS provides retirement, survivors and disability benefits.

FERS became effective January 1, 1987. Almost all new employees hired after December 31, 1983 are automatically covered by FERS. Certain other federal employees had the option to transfer into FERS. The cost of the FERS program, including Social Security, is the same as the cost of the CSRS program plus Medicare (8.70% in 1999). However the amount withheld from each portion is different. For FERS currently, 6.20% (Social Security) would be withheld on every dollar earned up to the maximum taxable amount of \$74,000 while the 1.45% would be withheld on every dollar earned for Medicare and the 1.05% FERS contribution would be withheld on the federal base pay only.

Employees covered by FERS receive Social Security credit and civil service credit. FERS employees who do not work a full Social Security covered career (35 years) are subject to the Windfall Elimination provision (WEP). FERS employees who have at least five years of FERS coverage are exempt from the Government Pension Offset (GPO).

FERS retirement benefits are basically computed by the following formula: (1 percent x years of service x high-3 year average salary) unless one retires at 62 or later with 20 or more years of service when the formula would become 1.1 percent.

A federal employee is entitled to an immediate retirement benefit if he/she meets one of the following sets of age and service requirements:

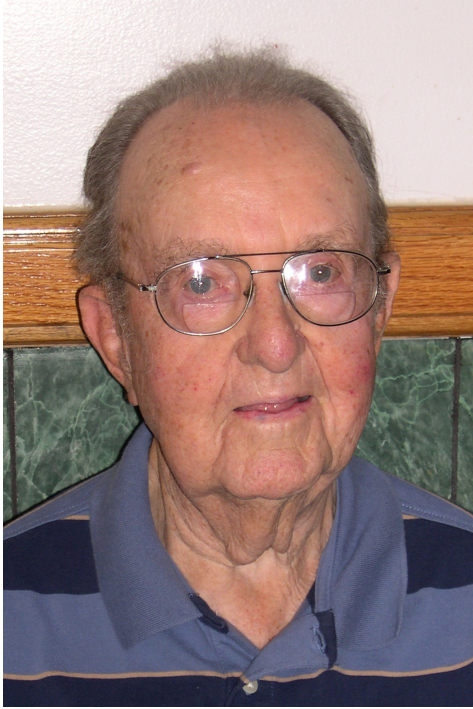

62	5
60	20
MRA	30
MRA	10 (Reduced benefit)

MRA or Minimum Retirement Age ranges from 55 -57.

These regional coordinators meet as a committee once a year, but all year round they are NARFE's "go to" group for our Alzheimer's program, functioning as facilitators, educators and encouragers in their respective regions to keep the research dollars coming in and to answer questions and provide resources for federations and chapters, in conjunction with National Headquarters and the Alzheimer's Association. All NARFE donations to the NARFE-Alzheimer's Fund are allocated to research. The Alzheimer's Association does not use NARFE donations to reimburse NARFE for administrative expenses incurred in the operation of the program. NARFE National President Margaret L. Baptiste is the oversight officer for the NARFE-Alzheimer's program. President Baptiste also served as the oversight officer during her four-year tenure as National Vice President, and feels that NARFE members can rightfully be proud of the phenomenal accomplishment of raising over \$7 million dollars for research since the program's inception. At the 2006 National Convention, NARFE delegates voted to make \$8 million our next goal.
