NARFE disaster funds in the form of cash grants (\$500 maximum per grant per household) are available to all NARFE members in good standing who have been injured, incurred property damage or have other needs during and after a declared natural disaster. Eligible damaged property must be a primary place of residence. Documentation is required to show loss or destruction of property or how the applicant was (continued on page 2)

injured as a result of a natural disaster. Grant checks are payable directly to the applicant or to a specific creditor.

History: In 1986, the Federal Employee Education & Assistance Fund (FEEA) was established to provide emergency grants and loans to federal employees affected by a natural disaster. NARFE's involvement with FEEA began following the April 19, 1995, bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City. NARFE chapters, federations and individual members donated \$100,000 to the FEEA's Oklahoma City Fund. NARFE's Oklahoma City donation helped fund full college scholarships for all 200 children who lost a federal employee parent in the bombing of the Murrah Building.

In 1996, NARFE partnered with FEEA to provide emergency disaster assistance to NARFE members who are victims of a declared natural disaster through the NARFE-FEEA Disaster Fund. The Fund is supported by tax-deductible donations from NARFE members and friends of NARFE, and is administered by FEEA. NARFE members have donated some \$375,000 in aid to NARFE members who were affected by Hurricane Katrina and other natural disasters. NARFE became a member of FEEA's board of directors in 1997.

The Social Security Fairness Act of 2021 (HR-82, introduced by Rep. Rodney Davis, R-IL) would eliminate the Government Pension Offset (GPO) and the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP). ### NC BAILEY EXPANSION

NC House Bill 52 (Sponsor Rep. Mike Clampitt, R-Haywood/Jackson/Swain) would make more retired federal employee pensions exempt from NC income tax. Currently under review by the House Finance Committee. More info at https://www.ncleg.gov/BillLookUp/2021/h52
